1879, *Roderick MacRae*; 1888, *Donald MacRae*; 1890, *Roderick MacRae*; 1902, *John MacRae*; 1903, *John Macrae's Reps/Widow John Macrae (no son or anyone able to pay)*; 1908, *Grace MacRae*

In 1901 it was noted that John MacRae was a helpless invalid, bedridden; in 1903 it was noted there was no son or anyone able to pay
